

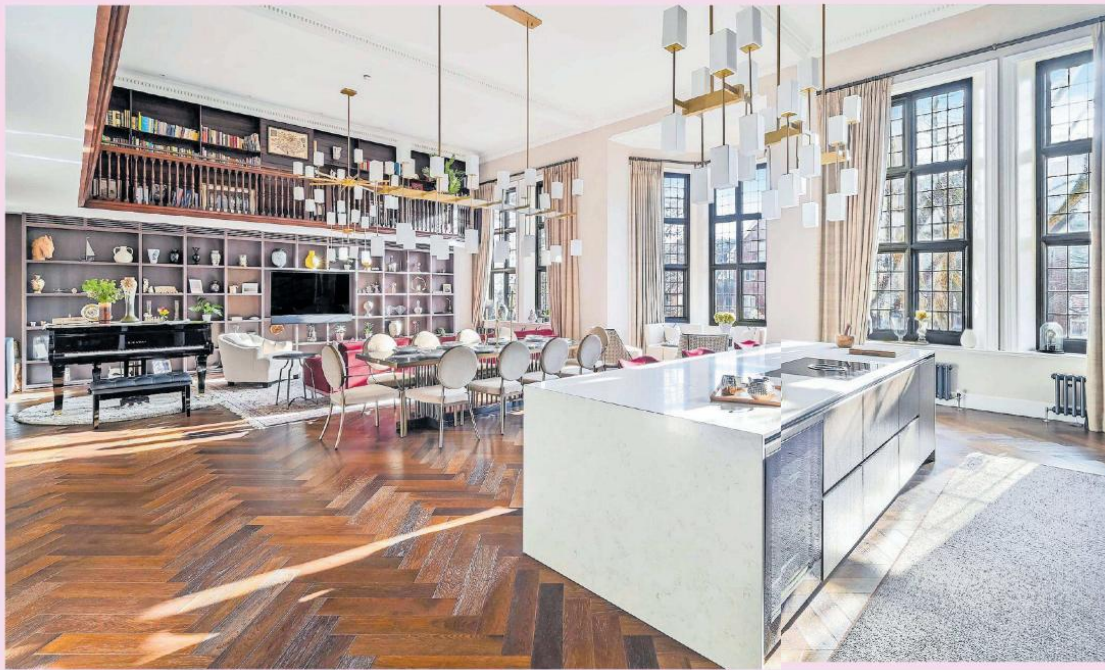

**LONDON NW3 £6.5M**

Skeel Library was built in 1903 for Westfield College, one of the first institutions in the UK dedicated to higher education for women. Now, the handsome grade II listed former library is part of the Hampstead Manor development, moments from Hampstead Heath.
